

## **Fujitsu Introduces the World's Smallest Colour Automatic Document Feed Scanner**

### ***New ScanSnap S300 Scanning Solution Enables Anytime, Anywhere Scanning for the Home Consumer, Home Worker (SOHO) and Mobile Professional; Includes OrganizeMy Electronic Filing Cabinet for Dummies***

**Mississauga, Ontario (November 26, 2007)** — Fujitsu Canada, Inc. today introduced the easy to use Fujitsu ScanSnap S300 scanning solution, the world's smallest colour, automatic document feeder (ADF) scanner. At eight double-sided pages per minute (ppm), the ScanSnap S300 is a performance leader in its category. With an ultra-compact footprint measuring just 11.2" x 3.7" x 3.0" and weighing approximately 3 lbs., the ScanSnap S300 scanner is small enough to fit on a desk or in a briefcase or laptop bag. The ScanSnap S300 is ideal for three groups: 1) the home consumer 2) the home worker (SOHO) and 3) the mobile professional. With the ScanSnap S300, Fujitsu offers consumers and home-based workers an easy solution to electronically organize bills, statements, receipts and other documents at home. For traveling professionals such as insurance or real estate agents, the ScanSnap S300's portability provides the ability to scan customer documents anywhere at anytime and complete business transactions more efficiently.

The ScanSnap S300 includes a standard version of OrganizeMy(TM) Electronic Filing Cabinet For Dummies® from Org-Matters Solutions Inc. The Electronic Filing Cabinet For Dummies software organizes your personal life, by electronically capturing everything from tax receipts and financial statements, to warranty cards and your favourite recipes.

The new ScanSnap S300 scanning solution offers the fastest "one-touch" conversion of paper documents into Adobe® portable document format (PDF) files available today in the mobile scanning industry. Users simply load a stack of up to 10 documents into the ADF and press the "SCAN" button to produce PDF files at speeds of up to 8 pages per minute (ppm) for single-sided documents and 16 images per minute (ipm) for double-sided documents. The ScanSnap S300 scanner can also be powered from a USB connection (USB 2.0/USB 1.1) on any PC, allowing traveling professionals to scan documents, receipts, bills, invoices and business cards anywhere they go.

"The ScanSnap S300 scanning solution packs a ton of valuable features into an ultra-compact scanner for the traveling professional, home office worker, or consumer looking to digitize and organize important documents," said Steve Oblin, marketing manager, imaging products, Fujitsu Canada, Inc. "In particular, mobile professionals who need to scan contracts, receipts and other

documents while traveling benefit from the S300's light weight, compact size and USB bus power support.”

For the home worker (SOHO), ScanSnap S300 comes bundled with ScanSnap Organizer for managing business documents, CardMinder for managing business cards and QuickMenu for simple Scan to Email, Scan to Folder and Scan to Print capabilities.

Other scanning features and software bundles included with the ScanSnap S300 scanner include:

- **Fast Scanning Speeds** – At 8 ppm (simplex) and 16 ipm (duplex), the ScanSnap S300 scanner provides excellent colour batch scanning performance. If AC power is unavailable, the ScanSnap S300 scanner can be connected to a second actively powered USB port on any PC and provide colour batch scanning speeds of up to 4 ppm (simplex) and 8 ipm (duplex).
- **Business Card Scanning** – CardMinder™ V3.2 transforms business cards into editable information and can export contacts to other contact managers such as Microsoft Outlook®, and Outlook Express.
- **Fujitsu ScanSnap Organizer V3.2** – Provides advanced viewing and control of scanned content, including large thumbnails consisting of all the pages scanned within the batch.
- **Double-Sided Colour Scanning** – Faithfully reproduces both sides of a document in a single pass.
- **Automatic Colour Detection** – Multi-page documents containing colour, black and white, text and graphic information on both sides are processed with the touch of a button.
- **Automatic Blank-Page Detection and Deletion** – Capability to sense whether a page is blank and eliminate it from the scan if the user so desires.
- **Automatic Page Orientation** – Allows the user to set the scanner to detect for automatic page orientation for proper viewing.
- **Automatic Image Deskew** – Automatically senses when images are misaligned (skewed) and corrects the alignment automatically before presenting the final image to the user.
- **Automatic Paper-Size Detection** –The ScanSnap S300 automatically detects paper sizes from business cards to legal length.
- **Dual 600dpi Optical Resolution** – Offers dual 600dpi optical resolution ensuring the highest image quality possible in a compact, mobile device. Users have their choice of setting scanning modes of Normal (150dpi colour), Better (200dpi colour), Best (300dpi colour), and Excellent (600dpi colour).

- **Document Protection** – ScanSnap Manager enables users to password protect PDF files – important when scanning sensitive documents.
